2017 Comp League Rules

1. Shooting Position

- a. Leagues will be shot from the 18 meter line.
- b. If you shoot a top target the first half of scoring then you will shoot a bottom target second half of scoring, depending on the size of the league.

2. Handicap

- a. Is only applied when divisions are mixed.
- b. Handicaps are derived by 50% of the difference between your individual average and a perfect score. Handicaps will not bring a shooter above a perfect score of 300.

3. Score

- a. Ranks are calculated with raw scores, unless handicaps are given as a result of recurve and compound mixed division.
- b. A shooter's two lowest scores are dropped when determining the ranks.
- c. Ranks scores will be posted each week on Facebook.

4. Equipment

- a. Crossbows and handmade/homemade bows are prohibited from league.
- b. Field or target tips only. No tips can be larger than the arrow shaft. Arrows must 23 or smaller in diameter.
- c. You may not make major changes in equipment, such as going from a recurve to a compound during the same quarter session, or upgrading from a traditional/hunting bow to a target bow.
- d. Equipment classifications for registration will be done within the first week of league.
- e. In the event of equipment failure you may stop shooting, make repairs, and continue shooting where you left off and finish as many missed rounds as can be completed in 30 mins after the final end of shooting that same night. Otherwise missed ends will be scored as zeros if they run over the 30 min buffer.

5. Shoot Schedule

- a. League rounds will be shot on Thursdays starting at 6:30 PM.
- b. Thirty minutes prior to the start of league is the allotted warm up time for any league participants.
- c. League scores must be turned at the end of league night each week.
- d. Boosting scores is prohibited. If a participant is suspected of boosting scores, they will first be warned and scoring will be done by league facilitators. If a participant is caught boosting scores, this will result in

- zeroed scores for the entirety of the league, stripped of any previous league winnings, and permanent ejection.
- e. League is scheduled by 10 Ring Archery Club, LLC. If a league night is cancelled, 10 Ring Archery League, LLC. will schedule a makeup date during the break between shooting quarters. Emails will be sent out if possible in the event of any cancellation, but please be sure to check Facebook for league announcements first.

6. **Scoring**

- a. 300 Round: 10 ends 3 arrows per end possible score of 300 points total
- b. Three Spot (Compound): 10, 9, 8, 7, 6 pts scoring matrix; Single Spot (Recurve): 10-1 pt scoring matrix
- c. X Shots will be used in the result of a tie, then 10s and then 9s if necessary.
- d. No one scores themselves. This is mandatory!
- e. No arrows will be touched or pulled until all arrows are scored. Any arrows that are touched or pulled before scoring will result in a 0 for that target for that person.
- f. Arrows must touch or break the line to score the higher point value.
- g. Arrows that bounce out will be judged by a program facilitator based on the target face and previously marked shots.
- h. A dropped arrow that is in front of the line counts as a shot taken.
- i. Scoring disputes are judged by the program facilitators only.

7. Awards

- a. Awards are awarded for 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place, or will be determined by size of league.
- b. Cash prizes may be available depending on the number of participants in the Grand Finale Tournament.

8. League Fees

- a. \$125.00 per person must be paid in advance of the first week of league meeting. Late registrations may be possible if spots are available and any missed weeks will not be allowed for make ups as a result of late registration.
- b. The league fees are used for awards, targets, and range maintenance.
- Missed weeks cannot be refunded or prorated.
- d. Payment Plan fees are as follows: \$50 downpayment and then \$10 each week for league until the end of the session.
- e. Partial refunds can be given if cancelled before the first meeting of league. There will be a 30% penalty for cancellation. No refunds of league fees after the first week for any reason.

9. If a Shooter Is Unable To Shoot

- a. Archers will be allowed to make up missed weeks under the following conditions: you must come in for your make up round prior to the following Thursday. This means your scores must be submitted and signed off on by close of business on Wednesday.
- b. Archers can only make up 2 rounds in a row and then they must be present on the third Thursday or their scores will be marked as 0 in value.
- c. If a shooter fails to shoot for any week, or show up on the third Thursday after two consecutive make up rounds, then their scores will result in zero points.
- d. A shooter is allowed 2 drop weeks for any reason or simply drop the lowest 2 scores. The 10 best scoring weeks of 12 will be used for scoring.

10. Health

- a. If the shooter has any major medical conditions or injuries, the league facilitators should be made aware of them prior to shooting and may require a medical release from their physician depending on the condition or injury.
- Any and all medical information that the shooter chooses to share with the league facilitators will remain completely confidential and will not be shared outside of the league facilitators.
- c. If any medical documentation or releases are provided, they will be destroyed or returned at the conclusion of the league or Grand Finale tournament if the shooter qualifies and chooses to participate.

11. Range Use

- a. See 10RAC's Indoor Range Rules.
- b. Warm up time starts 30 mins prior to scheduled league time.
- No shooting after league ends.
